

How our Welton Sports Premium was spent in 2016 -2017

We have used our Sports Premium funding to:

1. Develop and add to the PE and sports that Welton already offers
2. Make improvements now that will benefit pupils joining the school in the future

The area of cost have been broken down, please see below.

After school clubs

- School sports clubs were funded by the school and therefore free of charge to pupils across both Key Stages
- A lunch time games club was funded in order to support less able pupils and promote pupil leadership skills

Staff Training and Continuing Professional Development for Teachers

- Supply teacher cover costs were met so that the teacher responsible for PE could be released to attend Networking and Development meetings organised by School Sports Partnership and other initiatives
- Supply teacher cover costs were met so that the PE co-ordinator could be released in order to complete essential subject leadership activities such as PE audit and action planning
- Active Lunchtime development including purchase of resources to support Year 5 Play Leaders and SMSA's
- Basketball curriculum delivery (Term 3, 5 weeks in Year 3)
- Outdoor Adventurous Activities curriculum delivery and Professional Development for all teachers (KS1 and 2)

Promotion of Whole School Daily Physical Activity

- Purchase of resources to support Daily Physical Activity Roadshow initiative with Brendan Rouse
- Purchase of resources to support Move a Mile initiative
- Subscription to online resources used in class and at playtimes to encourage home daily physical activity

Introduction of New PE/Sporting experiences

- Yr2 and 3 Skipping Workshop
- Cycling Proficiency classes

Memberships and Licenses

- Membership of School Sports Partnership
- Funding for Head Teacher to complete Minibus Driving License. This has enabled school pupils to attend a greater number of Local and National sporting events such as BANES Cross Country and Rugby Matches in London.

Improvement/supplementation of existing PE Schemes, facilities and resources

- Purchase of resources to supplement FUN's scheme
- Purchase of new netball posts, netballs and bibs; Purchase of new football kits for both squads;
- Purchase of multi-sport equipment for a range of new activities;
- purchase of participation/recognition/reward resources E.g. medals, stickers, trophies
- Cost of marking school pitch (autumn/summer)
