Pupils at Welton have developed key skills in PE and staff are more confident in teaching and assessing these (personal) skills in light of the new curriculum. Up and Under Sports coaches are used to coach and develop key skills in staff and pupils. Staff report growing confidence in delivering high quality PE and physical activity lessons. The school now have a football and netball team and have taken part in a number of inter school tournaments. Also a cheerleading and dance team who have performed publically (with kit purchased through sports premium). This has resulted in a positive attitude to participation of sport from pupils	£8299
